BARCLAY FARM SWIM CLUB RULES

Please see the web site or office for the complete text of these rules.

Failure to comply with the rules may result in disciplinary actions.

1. Members are responsible for the conduct of their guests.
2. Children under 10 must be accompanied by a responsible member at least 14 years old.
3. Children younger than 14 must pass a qualifying "band test" before entering areas of the pool over their head unless directly supported by a parent or responsible swimmer. Direct support is defined as being able to offer immediate, in-water assistance.
4. Flotation devices may only be used with direct parent or responsible swimmer support.
5. No hanging on lane lines.
6. Non-swimmers shall remain in areas of the pool where they can keep their heads above water unless directly supported by a parent or responsible swimmer.
7. Running and ball playing are not permitted on any concrete areas.
8. Spitting, spouting water, blowing noses and urinating in the pool are strictly prohibited.
9. Lifeguards instructions must be followed. Distracting lifeguards is not permitted.
10. Air mattresses, rafts and inner tubes are prohibited except during designated times.
11. No glass is allowed in the pools or on the decks of the pools.
12. No diving is permitted from the sides of the pool into shallow water.
13. Diving or jumping off the side of the diving well is not permitted unless the lifeguard on duty has declared that the diving well is open for swimming. As long as the diving well is open for swimming, no jumping or diving from the diving boards is permitted.
14. All persons diving from the diving boards must:
 - Swim directly to and leave the water by means of the closest ladder,
 - Go straight off the end - not at an angle and not off the sides - of the board,
 - Not dive until the preceding diver has reached the exit ladder,
 - Only take one bounce on the Board,
 - Not begin climbing the diving board ladder until the preceding diver has jumped off.
 - Be at least 42" tall to use the high board unless directly supervised by parent,
 - Never climb down the diving board ladders -- if you go up, you must go off!
15. Use of the wading pool shall be limited to children under 8 years of age. Parents must assume responsibility for their own children in the wading pool and must attend them directly. No lifeguards are assigned to the wading pool area.
16. Children who are not toilet trained are not permitted in the main pool, unless they are wearing rubberized pants or swim diapers.
17. Persons who wish to swim laps have priority in the lap lane.
 - Persons must keep out of the lap lane when it is in use by a lap swimmer.
 - The lap lane is available to lap swimmers on a first-come, first-served basis.
 - Persons under 18 must not use the lap lane when an adult wishes to swim laps.
 - Kick boards are permitted in the lap lane for use by lap swimmers.
18. Every member is strongly encouraged to report promptly to the Pool Manager or a lifeguard any unsafe conditions or any facilities in need of repair.
19. Thunder or lightning require immediate evacuation of pools and deck areas. Reentry is permitted when announced by the Pool Manager and no less than 30 minutes after the last instance of thunder or lightning.
20. The Pool Manager shall refuse admission to the Swim Club facilities to any person who:
 - Appears to be intoxicated or under the influence of drugs, or
 - Is under suspension for failure to obey Club rules and regulations.
21. All injuries must be reported immediately to the Pool Manager or a Lifeguard.
22. All bicycles and wheeled vehicles must be placed neatly in or near the bicycle rack.
23. No pool use by persons with colds, inflamed eyes, infections, open sores or diarrhea.
24. Members are urged to report to the Pool Manager or a lifeguard any unsafe behavior of a member or guest that could result in injury to a person or damage to Swim Club property.
